



Elegant, graceful, aristocratic

No trace of plainness or coarseness



NOTE: Long ears set approximately on level with outer corners of the eyes

Proudly carried head (and tail)

Unusual coat pattern



The Afghan Hound has a straight front, proudly carried head...

(note that <u>straight front</u> refers to the <u>unbowed</u> front legs, <u>NOT</u> straightness of shoulder or upper arm)




The Afghan Hound has a straight front, proudly carried head...

BREED TYPE Square outline

The height at the shoulders equals the distance from the chest to the buttocks; the brisket well let down, and of medium width.



BREED TYPESquare outline



Sometimes the amount of coat can be deceiving and can make the dog look shorter on leg or longer backed. This dog is square although his length of body coat makes him look slightly off. <u>A short loin</u> is important for a strong topline!



NOTE: NOSE good size & black in color ...


Afghan Hound MOVEMENT ...



Good Balanced REACH & DRIVE ###### TRAD



Loose lead, reconnaissance trot, natural head & tail carriage



A profuse coat

<u>May Give</u> the illusion of front feet being thrown outward

BUT

This dog is moving cleanly in a straight line



From the rear & notice their large feet again
