


Faults

Coat

Color: Brindle. Base ranges from silver, cream to deep red.

Small amounts of white on chest and toes permitted.

Brindle pattern is easily seen on short hair, less so on the long and rough.

Short hair-Hard, not too short. Wooly undercoat.

Ruff, breeches and tail plume are clearly present.

Long hair-Long and straight, without curls or waves. Wooly undercoat.

Well fitting. Harsh to touch. Distinct ruff and breeches. Tail abundantly coated.

Head, ears, feet, hind legs below the hock are short and densely coated. No fringes on ears.

Rough hair—Dense, Harsh, tousled coat. Wooly undercoat, except for head.

Upper and lower lips well covered with hair.

Whiskers, beard and eyebrows.

- Wedge-shaped when viewed from above and in profile.
- · Skull: Flat.
- Muzzle: 1:1 ratio to length of Skull, and Parallel.
- Stop: Slight and Distinct.
- Eyes: Dark Brown, almond shaped, set obliquely.

- Nose: Black.
- · Lips: Tight and black.
- Teeth: Scissors bite, complete.
