



## *Judging the Pug – One Minute Summary* (in order of importance)

### *Head*

1. Large, Round, Massive Head (not apple headed)
2. Short Square Muzzle (not up-faced)
3. Slightly undershot bite (reverse scissor bite)

### *Proportions*

1. Square (measured from point of shoulder to rump)
2. Cobby (no tuck up)

### *Body*

1. Level Topline
2. High Set and Tightly Curled Tail
3. Front Legs Set Well Under
4. Moderate Bend of Stifle and Short Hocks
5. Neck of Sufficient Length to Carry Large Head Proudly

### *Movement*

1. Sound, Double Tracking Movement
2. Free, Self Assured, and Jaunty

### *Color*

1. Black
2. Fawn (may have black guard hairs)
3. Trace Down Back
4. Disqualify any color other than fawn or black
