

Judging the Pug – One Minute Summary (in order of importance)

Head

- 1. Large, Round, Massive Head (not apple headed)
- 2. Short Square Muzzle (not up-faced)
- 3. Slightly undershot bite (reverse scissor bite)

Proportions

- 1. Square (measured from point of shoulder to rump)
- 2. Cobby (no tuck up)

Body

- 1. Level Topline
- 2. High Set and Tightly Curled Tail
- 3. Front Legs Set Well Under
- 4. Moderate Bend of Stifle and Short Hocks
- 5. Neck of Sufficient Length to Carry Large Head Proudly

Movement

- 1. Sound, Double Tracking Movement
- 2. Free, Self Assured, and Jaunty

Color

- 1. Black
- 2. Fawn (may have black guard hairs)
- 3. Trace Down Back
- 4. Disqualify any color other than fawn or black
