



Gait: Free, balanced, vigorous, Good reach in forequarters & good drive in the hindquarters. At a fast trot, will single track. Back remains level, strong, firm and flat. Rear & front legs are thrown neither in or out.

Chest medium width, well filled

Sternum visible

Ribs well sprung, oval shape

Brisket to at least elbows

Elbows set close

Front legs straight, parallel, set moderately apart

Temperament combines spirit & alertness with intelligence & reliability. Amiable in repose & a commanding figure when aroused.

Croup full, slightly rounded

Thighs well muscled

Hocks short, perpendicular to ground & parallel

THE GIANT SCHNAUZER AT A GLANCE

A bold, valiant figure of a dog that is robust and strongly built

Head strong, rectangular, half the length of the back with parallel lines

Eyes oval, almond shaped, dark brown, deep set

Muzzle strong, well filled under the eyes

Bite full compliment of teeth, scissors bite ideal

Shoulders well laid back, forms right angle with upper arm

Chest medium width, breastbone plainly discernable with strong fore chest

Forelegs straight & vertical, good bone

Strong Pasterns
Feet well arched, compact, catlike

Ears cropped or uncropped, proportionate to head, set high.

Neck strong, well arched, moderate length

Body robust & compact, substantial, short coupled

Rib Cage well sprung

Back short, straight, strong, firm

Coat hard, wiry, dense with soft undercoat & harsh outer coat

Colors: Pure Black small white chest spot allowed Pepper/Salt with banded hairs, white or nearly white furnishings

Tail set moderately high Docked approx. 1.5"-3

Hindquarters strongly muscled

Stifles well bent

Hocks short, perpendicular to ground, parallel to each other

Brisket deep, at least to elbows

Height: Males 25.5"-27.5" Females 23.5"-25.5" Mediums desired

Disqualifying faults: Overshot or undershot bite. Markings other than specified
