General Appearance

Sturdy, lively, alert toy. Long flowing double coat. Proud of bearing, distinctively arrogant carriage with head well up and tail curved over back. Compact, solid, good weight & substance.




Size / Substance / Proportion

Regardless of size, always compact, solid, & carries good weight & substance.

Weight: 9 to 16 pounds

Proportion: withers to root of tail slightly longer

than height at withers.



Head Developed by Karen Scholz 100177

Round, broad, wide between eyes, in balance with overall size of dog. Warm, sweet, wide eyed, friendly and trusting expression Skull domed with definite stop



Ears
Large, set slightly below crown of skull,
Heavily coated



Eyes

Large, round, not prominent placed well apart, Very dark, lighter on liver & blue pigmented dogs.

Fault: Small, close set, light or excessive white in eyes



Nose: nostrils broad, wide, open Nose, lips, eye rims black on all colors except Liver & blue self colored Fault: pink on nose, lips or eye rims

Muzzle square, short, unwrinkled w good cushioning set no lower than bottom eye rim, Never downturned

Ideally no longer than 1 inch tip of nose to stop Front of muzzle flat

Lower chin/lip not protruding, not receding

Fault: snipiness, lack of definite stop

Teeth: Undershot

Jaw is broad & wide. Missing tooth or slightly unaligned teeth **not** severely penalized Teeth/Tongue do not show when mouth closed Fault: Overshot bite

Neck, Topline, Body

<u>Neck</u> Well set on flowing smoothly into shoulders. Of sufficient length to permit natural high head carriage in balance <u>Topline</u> level

<u>Chest</u> Broad, deep, good spring, not barrel <u>Body</u> Short coupled, sturdy, no tuck up Slightly longer than tall Elbow to withers slightly greater than

Croup flat

Fault: Legginess

elbow to ground



Angulation in balance with front
Hocks short, perpendicular to ground
Legs well boned, muscular, straight from rear
Well bent stifles, Hocks well let down, perpendicular
Dewclaws may be removed
Feet Firm, well padded, point straight ahead

Fault: Hyperextension of hocks

TAIL set on high, heavily plumed, carried in curve well over back.

Coat

Luxurious, double coated, dense, long, flowing Slight wave permissible, Hair top of head tied up

Fault: Sparse coat, single coat, curly coat Excessive trimming

Color

All are permissible and considered equally



Forequarters

Well angulated, well laid back, fitting smoothly into body

Pasterns strong, Perpindicular Legs straight, well boned, muscular, set well apart under chest, elbows close to body **Feet**

Firm, well padded, point straight ahead Dewclaws may be removed

<u>Temperament</u>

Outgoing, happy, affectionate, friendly & trusting towards all

Moves straight, must be shown at natural speed Smooth, flowing, effortless Good reach, strong drive Level topline, High head carriage Tail carried in gentle curve over back
